

## Schwibs Nominated for Regional Emmy Awards

Susanne Schwibs, long time adjunct instructor in film production in the Department of Communication and Culture, was nominated for two regional Emmy awards and was recognized at the 40<sup>th</sup> Annual Emmy Awards for the National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences: Lower Great Lakes chapter in Cleveland, Ohio on September 12, 2009.

Schwibs was nominated in the category Arts/Entertainment Special for her work on WTIU's *Wilderness Plots: Songs and Stories of the Prairie* as producer-director and in the category Informational Program or Series for her work on *American Horizons: the Photographs of Art Sinsabaugh* where she worked as producer, writer, and editor.

She was excited to learn that her recent production of *Harp Dreams* the documentary about the USA International Harp competition will be broadcast nationally on PBS. Next, she plans to begin work on a piece about labor leader and native Hoosier Eugene Debs.
