

Graduate/Professional School Access Award Application

Sponsored by HHSP-OMSLD

APPLICATION FOR CONSIDERATION

The Graduate/Professional School Access Award was established to help sophomores, juniors, and seniors enrolled in the Hudson & Holland Scholars Program (HHSP) or programs overseen by the Office of Mentoring Services and Leadership Development (OMSLD) — 21st Century Scholars, the Office of Strategic Mentoring, the Men of Color Leadership Institute and FASE Mentoring — overcome financial barriers preventing them from preparing for and applying to graduate or professional school. Students granted awards will receive financial support ranging from \$250 - \$1,000 to pay for a variety of expenses, including standardized test preparation and registration fees, books and materials, graduate school application fees, etc.)

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To be eligible to apply for the award, students must:

- Be an active and good-standing sophomore, junior, or senior within Hudson & Holland Scholars or OMSLD Programs, currently enrolled full-time at IU Bloomington
- Have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Have demonstrated financial need, defined by an EFC (Estimated Family Contribution) of \$1,000 or less, as determined by their 2009-2010 FAFSA

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Students who receive the award must agree to:

- 1) Meet with a staff member from their respective programs to finalize plans for using the award funds
- 2) Use award funds before the beginning of the spring 2010 semester
- 3) Attend at least one graduate school workshop sponsored by HHSP or OMSLD
- 4) Forward all standardized test results to HHSP or OMSLD
- 5) Notify HHSP or OMSLD of any graduate programs they are admitted to, or enroll in

If you meet the above eligibility criteria and agree to comply with the requirements stated above should you receive the award, please complete this application and email it as an attachment along with a copy of your resume or curriculum vitae to your respective program office: Hudson & Holland Scholars Program — hhsp@indiana.edu; Office of Mentoring Services and Leadership Development — OMSLD@indiana.edu.
