Fateless (Sorstalanság, lit. 'fatelessness' in Hungarian) is a movie directed by Lajos Koltai, released in 2005. It was based on the semi-autobiographical novel of the same title by the Nobel Prize winner author Imre Kertész, who also wrote the screenplay. It is the story of a teenage boy who is sent to concentration camps at Auschwitz, Buchenwald, and Zeitz.

Its music was composed by Ennio Morricone and one of its songs was sung by Lisa Gerrard. The film is not only one of the most expensive movie productions ever done in Hungary (it cost about \$12 million US to make) but also one of the most successful productions.

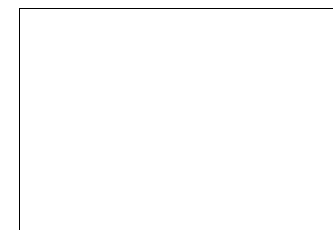

The Witness (Hungarian: A tanú, also known as Without A Trace), is a 1969 Hungarian satire film, directed by Péter Bacsó. The film was created in a tense political climate at a time when talking about the 1950s and the 1956 Revolution was still taboo. Interestingly, it was financed and allowed to be made by the communist authorities, however, it was subsequently banned from release. The first cinema showing of the film was successful, and it later became a cult film. As a result of its screening in foreign countries, the communist authorities eventually relented and allowed the film to be released in Hungary. The film would be screened at the 1981 Cannes Film Festival in the Un Certain Regard section.[1] A sequel was made in 1994 named "Megint tanú" (English: Witness Again).
