## INDIANA UNIVERSITY 2010-2011 SHORT-TERM FACULTY EXCHANGE PROGRAMS

Each year, the Office of the Vice President for International Affairs recruits faculty members and librarians for short-term (one month) assignments at partner institutions abroad during the calendar year. Please bring these opportunities to the attention of your department for the 2010-2011 year (July 1, 2010 – June 30, 2011).

Approximately two-thirds of the advertised positions will be funded. In most cases, the partner institution will provide a stipend to help offset local expenses and the Office of the Vice President for International Affairs will cover round-trip air transportation for the exchangee. Applications are screened by world area exchange committees and a final recommendation is made by the International Affairs Exchange Review Committee before sending dossiers to partner institutions for final approval.

Candidates may apply for an exchange position in order to conduct research, consult with colleagues, or offer lectures or short courses. Applicants should indicate how their proposals are important to their professional development, the development of a school or departmental affiliation, or the development of the partner institution. Research proposals should include an outline of the project and should specifically identify local resources the candidate would employ. An applicant who

proposes to offer lectures or a short course should provide confirmation that his/her topics are of interest to colleagues at the partner institution.

**General Descriptions of 2009**  
**Short-Term Exchange Positions at Partner Institutions**

**COSTA RICA: UNIVERSITY OF COSTA RICA:** IU has the opportunity to send one faculty member or librarian to the University of Costa Rica for one month between July 1, 2010 and June 30, 2011. Preliminary recommendations will be made by the University Committee on Latin American Exchanges. (Recommended that IU faculty member pre-identify counterpart to work with at University of Costa Rica).

**CROATIA: UNIVERSITY OF ZAGREB:** IU has the opportunity to send one faculty member or librarian every other year to the University of Zagreb for one month (next available July 1, 2010 – June 30, 2011). Preliminary recommendations will be made by the University Committee on Russian & East European Exchanges.

**GERMANY: BAYREUTH UNIVERSITY:** IU has the opportunity to send one faculty member or librarian to Bayreuth University for one month between July 1, 2010 and June 30, 2011. Preliminary recommendations will be made by the University Committee on West European Exchanges.

**GERMANY: HAMBURG UNIVERSITY:** IU has the opportunity to send up to two faculty members to Hamburg University for one month periods between July 1, 2010 and June 30, 2011. Preliminary recommendations will be made by the University Committee on West European Exchanges.

**HUNGARY: UNIVERSITY OF DEBRECEN:** IU has the opportunity to send one faculty member or librarian to the University of Debrecen for one month between July 1, 2010 and June 30, 2011. Preliminary recommendations will be made by the University Committee on Central Eurasian Exchanges.

**MEXICO: CENTER FOR HIGHER STUDIES AND RESEARCH IN SOCIAL ANTHROPOLOGY (CIESAS):** IU has the opportunity to send one faculty member or librarian to one of CIESAS six locations for one month between July 1, 2010 and June 30, 2011. Preliminary recommendations will be made by the University Committee on Latin American Exchanges.

**PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA: ZHEJIANG UNIVERSITY:** IU has the opportunity to send one faculty member or librarian to Zhejiang University for one month between July 1, 2010 and June 30, 2011. Preliminary recommendations will be made by the University Committee on Asian Exchanges.

**POLAND: JAGIELLONIAN UNIVERSITY:** IU has the opportunity to send one faculty member or librarian to Jagiellonian University for one month between July 1, 2010 and June 30, 2011. Preliminary recommendations will be made by the University Committee on Russian & East European Exchanges.

**POLAND: WARSAW UNIVERSITY:** IU has the opportunity to send one faculty member or librarian to Warsaw University for one month between July 1, 2010 and June 30, 2011. Preliminary recommendations will be made by the University Committee on Russian & East European Exchanges.

**RUSSIA: HIGHER SCHOOL OF ECONOMICS (HSE) MOSCOW:** IU has the opportunity to send one faculty member or librarian to HSE for one month between July 1, 2010 and June 30, 2011. This exchange is different in that the Office of the Vice President for International Affairs will be covering expenses for the trip through an Out-of-State Travel Reimbursement. Preliminary recommendations will be made by the University Committee on Russian & East European Exchanges.

SOUTH KOREA: YONSEI UNIVERSITY: IU has the opportunity to send one faculty member or librarian to Yonsei University for one month between July 1, 2010 and June 30, 2011. Preliminary recommendations will be made by the University Committee on Asian Exchanges.

SPAIN: UNIVERSITY OF SEVILLE: IU has the opportunity to send one faculty member or librarian to University of Seville for one month between July 1, 2010 and June 30, 2011. Preliminary recommendations will be made by the University Committee on West European Exchanges.

THAILAND: CHULALONGKORN UNIVERSITY: IU has the opportunity to send one faculty member to Chulalongkorn University for one month between July 1, 2010 and June 30, 2011. Preliminary recommendations will be made by the University Committee on Asian Exchanges.

THAILAND: NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRATION (NIDA): IU has the opportunity to send one faculty member to NIDA for one month between July 1, 2010 and June 30, 2011. Preliminary recommendations will be made by the University Committee on Asian Exchanges.
