International Student Admission Guidelines

In addition to the guidelines above, all international applicants must have a TOEFL score that meets or exceeds the following:

- Internet-based: 100
- Computer-based: 250
- Paper-based: 600

Additionally, students wishing to complete a clinical Master's or AuD degree, will first be admitted into a non-clinical track until they have received satisfactory scores on the two following tests, which can be completed upon arrival to Indiana University:

1. Indiana English Proficiency Examination (pass/fail scoring)
2. Test of English Proficiency for International Associate Instructor Candidates (score of C2 or C1)
